A Day at the Dollenberg

The day begins in stillness. Only birdsong and the gentle light rising over the Black Forest hills. You open the window. Cool, crisp air carries the scent of woodland and a sense of freedom. No traffic, no noise. Just nature, quietly breathing.

A knock at the door. Breakfast is served – freshly brewed coffee, golden butter, crusty rolls, Black Forest ham, honey from the hotel's own park and, for those who wish, a glass of champagne. Outside, the morning dew sparkles. Inside, a gentle warmth radiates comfort and care. Some begin the day in

bed, others in the restaurant, where the buffet tempts with fragrant pastries, fresh fruit and hot dishes. The view across the valley stirs a quiet sense of gratitude. With every breath, you feel it: You have arrived. The day is yours.

HIKING & CULINARY DELIGHTS

Soon after, it's time to lace up your walking boots. The path winds through forests, over babbling brooks and along soft mossy trails. Birds call overhead, golden light filters through the treetops. The

ascent to the Teufelskanzel – the 'Devil's Pulpit' – is well worth the effort: ahead lies the Wishing Table experience. A breathtaking view unfolds – the Black Forest in all its splendour, with the Rhine plain stretching towards the distant Vosges.

Almost like scene from a fairytale, laid tables appear amid the greenery. The culinary hike, long a Dollenberg tradition, offers a four-course menu served beneath the open sky, accompanied by wines from the region. The kitchen works its magic and nature provides the stage. This is indulgence at its purest.

Back at the resort, the DOLLINA Spa & Health awaits – 5,000sqm of pure relaxation. A dip in the shimmering pool, a few laps under the open sky, the sun warm on your skin. Everyday life feels far away.

At the pool bar, the scent of the barbecue drifts through the air – tender meats, fresh fish and seasonal vegetables from the grill. Perhaps a chilled rosé or a well-crafted cocktail. The afternoon is dedicated to unwinding. For those who wish, there's a massage, a thalassotherapy session or a beauty treatment. In the sauna, soothing infusions alternate with quiet moments, while steam and the scent of pine fill the air. Time simply slips away – just as it should.

Sitting between sky and forest, listening to the hum of bees and the breeze through the grass, you begin to understand what makes this place so special.

The Black Forest High Road & Baden- Baden – *Nature & World-Class Culture*

For those keen to explore, one of Europe's most scenic routes awaits: the *Schwarzwaldhochstraße* – the Black Forest High Road. Winding from the heights of the Dollenberg through dense woodland and open uplands, it passes viewpoints such as the *Schliffkopf* summit, *Lake Mummelsee* and *Bühlerhöhe*. Time and again, the landscape opens out, revealing sweeping views across the Rhine plain, with vineyards and villages that look as if they've been painted into place.

This road is more than a route – it's an experience. A journey

through wild natural beauty, crisp air and expansive vistas. Every kilometre reflects the spirit of the Black Forest – untamed, powerful, authentic.

At the far end lies Baden-Baden – cosmopolitan, charming and timelessly elegant. A city steeped in world-class culture, yet still deeply connected to its Black Forest roots. Stroll along the *Lichtentaler Allee* and you'll sense the glamour of past eras paired with contemporary sophistication. Boutiques, cafés, the casino and the *Festspielhaus* opera and concert

hall are all within easy reach, each offering its own distinctive flair.

Art lovers are drawn to the Frieder Burda Museum, music enthusiasts to the Festspielhaus. Baden-Baden is where world-class culture, history and *joie de vivre* meet – just an hour from the Dollenberg.

The Black Forest High Road – *A Journey Through Nature and Time*

GERMANY'S OLDEST SCENIC ROAD – DESIGNED FOR DISCOVERY AND DELIGHT

No trip to the Black Forest would be complete without experiencing one of its most iconic routes: the Black Forest High Road. For over a century, this scenic route has drawn visitors and remains one of Europe's most breathtaking drives. Originally built in the early 20th century to open up the northern Black Forest – first for horse-drawn carriages, then for early motorists – it quickly became a magnet for day-trippers from Baden-Baden, Strasbourg and Freiburg. The idea behind it was simple: to make the Black Forest something to be experienced. The aim was to combine fresh mountain air, sweeping views and nature, creating an irresistible draw for visitors. The result was a high-altitude road that has never lost its appeal.

The route begins near the heights of the Dollenberg and winds its way through bends, dense forests and open ridges. Along the way, it passes landmarks that are quintessentially Black Forest: the *Schliffkopf* summit with its far-reaching views, the mysterious *Mummelsee* tarn, and the grand historic setting of Bühlerhöhe. Each stop offers its own perspective – whether it's natural wonder or cultural heritage. At intervals, the road opens up to the Rhine plain below – with views of vineyards, orchards and picturesque villages.

Offering an extraordinary experience made up of fresh mountain air, peaceful moments, dramatic outlooks and a sense of freedom, this road captures the spirit of the Black Forest: wild, powerful, and authentic.



Baden-Baden – *Where Europe Came to Bathe*

A CITY OF THERMAL SPRINGS, ELEGANCE AND UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE

At the northern end of the Black Forest High Road lies Baden-Baden – a city long renowned as one of Europe's most distinguished spa destinations. People have been coming here to bathe since Roman times, followed in later centuries by aristocrats, industrialists, artists and writers. Empress Elisabeth of Austria, Tsar Nicholas I, Brahms, Clara Schumann,

Dostoevsky and Mark Twain – all sought out Baden-Baden for its curative waters, refined atmosphere and unique combination of elegance and ease. Baden-Baden understood early on that wellbeing, culture and architecture belong together. That's why so many of its buildings and landmarks still reflect that spirit today.

The landscaped beauty of Lichtentaler Allee is among the most picturesque park promenades in Europe. The lovingly tended rose garden and *Gönnernanlage* gardens offer quiet corners full of spa-town charm. The *Kurhaus*, with its renowned

casino, remains a glittering symbol of grandeur. At Iffezheim, the historic racecourse continues to host international events, while Baden-Baden's theatre, museums and the *Museum Frieder Burda* – with its striking modern design – celebrate a vibrant cultural scene. The *Festspielhaus*, Germany's largest opera and concert hall, is a beacon of world-class performance. And the SWR radio station, bringing contemporary cultural production to the city. Baden-Baden brings together history, art, music and a zest for life in close proximity.

Anyone strolling through the city feels both the legacy of its spa heritage and the elegance of the present day. Boutiques, cafés, parks and culture – everything is close at hand, and everything

has style. If you're looking for art, you'll find it. If you love music, you'll feel at home. If you're here to enjoy, you'll discover restaurants like Le Bistro – with a complimentary lunch menu included when using the Dollenberg GoldCard. Baden-Baden never tries to impress – but it always does. A World Heritage city, just an hour from the Dollenberg, it's a perfect pairing: the untamed beauty of the Black Forest and a city of timeless culture, side by side.



Bad Peterstal-Griesbach – *A Town of Springs and Stories*

WHERE WATER, NATURE AND HISTORY FLOW TOGETHER

Nestled at the foot of the Dollenberg, the spa town of Bad Peterstal-Griesbach is shaped by its waters, its landscapes and the tales they tell. In 2025, we looked back at its heritage – in 2026, we invite you to explore it in person. Whether on a gentle walk or a more ambitious hike, the valley offers an abundance of peaceful variety, just moments from the hotel.

For those seeking a more adventurous trail, the certified Wiesensteig route offers an authentic taste of the Black Forest. Expect gently rolling meadows, clear mountain streams and narrow forest paths – along with a charming regional tradition: the ‘schnapps fountain’. These roadside stops, run by local families, offer kirsch and other fruit brandies, a greeting from the valley.

It’s charming, sincere and low-key. That’s exactly what makes the Wiesensteig so special.

For a journey into the town’s spa origins, the *Sophienquelle* spring is a must-visit. This was the source that launched Bad Peterstal-Griesbach as a spa destination, once prized not only for its healing properties but also as a regional economic force. Today, quiet footpaths and information panels tell the story of bottling, export and the spa’s historical importance – an unhurried and rewarding experience. The town’s rich spa heritage is just as captivating. Even the Grand Duke of Baden and the Tsar of Russia once came to take the waters in Bad Peterstal-Griesbach. Another point of interest is the memorial plaque to Matthias

Erzberger, located at the site of his assassination in 1921. A key figure in post-war Germany, Erzberger signed the armistice that ended the First World War and, as Minister of Finance in 1919, swiftly introduced a pioneering financial system that laid the groundwork for Germany’s modern tax system.

Bad Peterstal-Griesbach is also where the Baden Constitution was signed. This later served as the basis for the German Constitution adopted in Frankfurt. It is for this reason that Baden-Württemberg is still referred to as the *Musterländle* – Germany’s ‘model region’. As Minister of Finance, Erzberger began working in 1919 to establish

unified tax laws for Germany – many of which remain in place today. A place of remembrance and a reminder that the Black Forest is more than just a natural backdrop: it is also a stage for German history. Low-key, poignant, and only a short walk from Hotel Dollenberg.

For sweeping views across Bad Griesbach, it’s worth making your way up to the summer ski jump. Quiet in winter, this ski-jumping hill becomes a panoramic viewpoint in the warmer months. The summer ski-jumping event is also a much-anticipated highlight on the town’s calendar.

This outing combines everything that makes Bad Peterstal-Griesbach special: water, nature, history, craftsmanship and moments of quiet surprise. A walk that speaks volumes without ever raising its voice – and it begins right at the Dollenberg.

FROM FARMHOUSE FARE TO FINE DINING

How Haute Cuisine *Came to the Dollenberg*

The scent of woodland, resin and freshly baked bread lingers in the air – behind this rural idyll lies a story of success that began in the Black Forest and continues to this day. Where once rustic meals and the aroma of smoked meats defined daily life, the arrival of classical French cuisine marked a turning point – and changed everything.

THE EARLY DAYS – FROM BOTTLED BEER TO FINE CUISINE

Around 50 years ago, **Meinrad Schmiederer** laid the foundation. From a modest bottled beer shop with a handful of guest rooms, he gradually created what is now recognised as one of Germany's leading five-star superior hotels.

A trained chef, educated in Freudenstadt, he spent decades at the stove himself before going on to study hotel management at the legendary Schlosshotel Bühlerhöhe. Early on, he recognised a simple truth: quality starts with the ingredients. Each morning, he would drive to **Strasbourg and Paris** to source fresh fish, the finest cuts of meat, lobster, vegetables and champagne – ingredients that were virtually unheard of in the Black Forest at the time. While elsewhere guests were still being served trout and German sparkling wine, the Dollenberg was offering lobster and Champagne. It was the beginning of a culinary revolution in the heart of the forest.

THE PROTÉGÉ – FROM APPRENTICE TO MICHELIN STARDOM

It was during this time that a young apprentice joined the kitchen: **Martin Herrmann**. Schmiederer recognised his potential, nurtured his talent and ultimately entrusted him with the reins. Herrmann turned his culinary vision into his life's work, bringing the first Michelin star to the Dollenberg 28 years ago. The second soon followed. For 15 years now, they have continued to shine above the restaurant *Le Pavillon* – a lasting tribute to a culinary philosophy rooted in the principles of Escoffier: clarity of composition, technical precision and a perfect balance of elegance and flavour.

BACK IN 1963

THE SPIRIT – FRENCH TRADITION, BLACK FOREST SOUL

The influence of nearby France has always been central. The Dollenberg became a bridge between two worlds: the grandeur of French haute cuisine and the grounded character of Baden. Game from local forests, herbs from the hotel's own garden, vegetables from nearby farms and wines from the Ortenau region provide the foundation. These are elevated using the very principles once taught by Escoffier – adapted to the times and the region, yet true to their essence.

TODAY – LUXURY ROOTED IN ORIGIN AND CRAFT

Today, haute cuisine in the Black Forest stands for sustainability, precision and authenticity. At **Le Pavillon**, luxury is not defined by excess but by true craftsmanship,

seasonal produce and the skill to create greatness from simplicity. Every plate tells a story – of forest, heritage and the global inspiration.

A LEGACY WITH A FUTURE

What began as a vision is now part of a culinary legacy. Today, the Dollenberg stands as a symbol of the Black Forest's emergence as a stronghold of haute cuisine.

From Meinrad Schmiederer's spirit and guiding hand to Martin Herrmann's modern interpretation, a story has unfolded over more than half a century. And that story continues – day by day, course by course, in the heart of the Black Forest.

AN INTERVIEW WITH MARTIN HERRMANN

Mr Herrmann, you're recognised as one of the most consistent and influential figures in haute cuisine – not only in the Black Forest but across Germany. How has haute cuisine in the region evolved over the years?

It's become lighter, more refined, more thoughtful. What was once a grand feast is now more of a journey through flavours. We think more carefully about origin, sustainability and balance. But the core principles remain unchanged: flavour and craftsmanship.

Your cuisine blends classical French haute cuisine with the culinary traditions of Baden. How do you maintain that balance between cosmopolitan flair and a sense of home?

By treating both with equal respect. My training is rooted in classical

French cuisine – that's my foundation. But my heart is here, in the Black Forest. I bring the two together: French technique, Baden soul. If a dish is technically flawless but evokes no emotion, then something essential is missing.

How important are local growers and producers to your work?

Absolutely essential. Nothing would be possible without them. I've worked with many of my suppliers for years – hunters, butchers, gardeners, farmers. We understand one another. They deliver outstanding quality because they know I honour their work on the plate.

Do you think haute cuisine will become more regional or more international in the future?

Both. The roots need to run deep – without them, nothing lasting can grow.

But if you're too inward-looking, you risk missing the richness of the wider world.

Is there a dish that best embodies the spirit of Le Pavillon?

Perhaps the venison with spätzle and cranberries. It's classic and honest – deeply rooted in the Black Forest – yet crafted with elegance and precision.

And your vision for the future of haute cuisine in the Black Forest?

That it stays true to itself. That the next generation of chefs understands our origins. The Black Forest offers everything – nature, ingredients, character. You can create cuisine of the highest calibre from that, without ever compromising its essence.

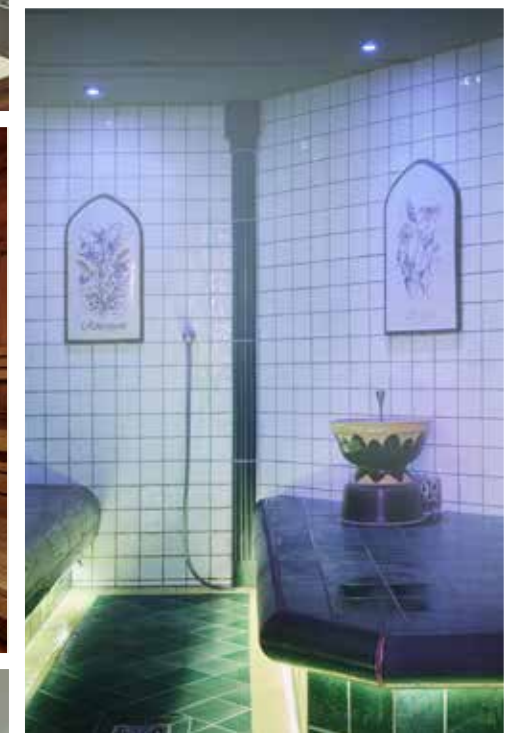
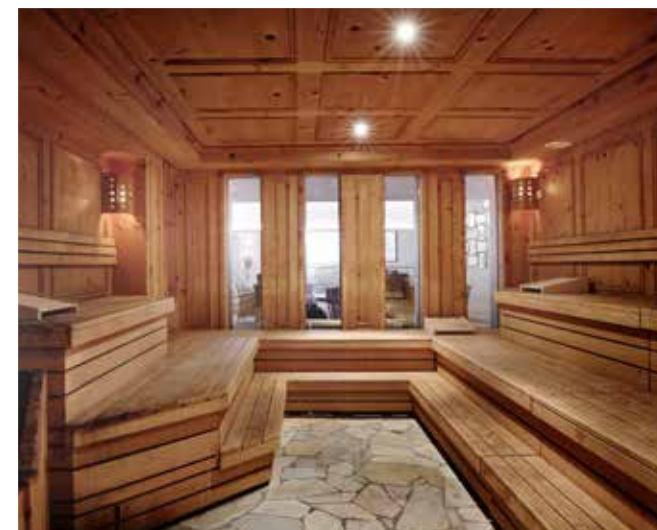

Salt is one of the world's oldest natural remedies. It detoxifies, restores and stimulates circulation. The gently salted water nourishes the skin, boosts the metabolism and supports the respiratory system. Just a few minutes are enough to relax the muscles and noticeably enhance wellbeing.

The warm saltwater feels like a protective space – the body floats, the mind lets go. As you immerse yourself, a deeply restorative balance unfolds: between lightness and depth, between calm and renewed energy.

Pure Wellness, *Straight from Nature*

We breathe in – not just forest air, but a profound sense of calm, freedom and stillness. Forest bathing – in Japan, known as *shūrin-yoku* – is far more than a walk. It's a conscious, immersive experience that brings us into gentle harmony with the natural world. No step count, no destination – just being present in the here and now. The Black Forest becomes a source of inner balance, a sanctuary where thoughts settle and what truly matters becomes clear.



It's early morning. The air is fresh and mild, the ground still damp with dew. The trail leads us through fir trees, moss and ferns. Sunlight breaks through the canopy, dancing across the forest floor, and with each breath comes the scent of resin and earth.

If you wish, take off your shoes – feel the ground, the moss, the soft needles, the life beneath your feet. Nature responds with gentle sounds: birdsong, the hum of insects, the rustle of wind through leaves.

Thoughts begin to fade, the pace slows – stillness takes hold.

FOREST BATHING IS ABOUT EXPERIENCING THE FOREST, NOT SIMPLY PASSING THROUGH IT.

Nowhere is this more profound than in the Black Forest National Park. Here, the forest grows wild and untouched – just as nature intended.

Science confirms what the body already knows: time spent in the

forest lowers stress hormones, strengthens the heart and immune system, and promotes deeper sleep. The trees' essential oils – terpenes – unfold their soothing effects with every breath.

Yet beyond all the studies, forest bathing remains above all one thing: a quiet gift.

Here, in the natural surroundings of the Dollenberg, we feel something shift. Breathing slows, shoulders ease, the mind grows

light. Each step takes us deeper into a calm where strength and serenity meet.

FOREST BATHING AT THE DOLLENBERG IS NOT A METHOD – IT'S AN EXPERIENCE.

A return to the source, to a world where phones fall silent and the heart finds its voice.

The Black Forest here is more than a backdrop – it's a living source of health, mindfulness and renewed energy.

Those who open themselves to it may find comfort, peace – and perhaps a part of themselves.

The Forest as Therapist

BLOOD PRESSURE & STRESS

- Regular time spent in the forest can help lower blood pressure – on average by around 3 mmHg.
- Cortisol levels decrease noticeably.
- The heart and nervous system begin to re-regulate, shifting the body into a natural state of rest. (Sources: ResearchGate, Frontiers 2024–2025)

HEART & CIRCULATION

- After forest bathing, the heart rate slows and becomes more even.
- Heart rate variability – a key indicator of resilience to stress – improves. (Source: BES Journals)

MOOD & MENTAL WELLBEING

- Even brief periods spent in green environments improve mood, reduce anxiety and ease inner restlessness.
- Recent studies show forest bathing can reduce rumination and support emotional balance. (Sources: Wiley Online Library, ScienceDirect)

SLEEP & ENERGY

- Regular forest visits are linked with better sleep quality and more restful nights.
- At the same time, the immune system is activated – including an increase in certain types of defence cells. (Source: Frontiers)

IMMUNE SYSTEM BOOST

- Studies in Japan and South Korea show that after extended time in the forest, the number of killer cells – which help combat pathogens and tumour cells – rises significantly.
- Researchers believe essential plant compounds (*phytoncides*) may play a key role. (Source: PMC)

Useful Information

Just two hours of forest bathing per week can have a measurable and positive effect on health and wellbeing. Ideally, practise it two to three times a week for 20 to 40 minutes at a time.

Nature leads the way – guiding us back to ourselves, and back to our true nature.



Forest Bathing – How It's Done

SLOW AND MINDFUL

Walk without a set destination or pace. Breathe deeply. Let the forest speak through sights, sounds and sensations.

AWAKEN THE SENSES

- Listen to the forest
- Inhale the scent of moss, earth and resin
- Feel the texture of bark, the coolness of the air, the play of light

TIME, NOT DISTANCE CREATE YOUR OWN RHYTHM, FOR EXAMPLE:

- 5 minutes of conscious breathing
- 20 minutes of silent walking
- 10 minutes of mindful stillness

- **Renchtalhütte & Surroundings:** Quiet clearings and forest sections right by the Renchtalhütte – perfect for stillness and presence.
- **Wiesensteig Trail:** Surrounded by pristine forest, soft moss and birdsong – a place of calm energy.
- **Dollenberg Hotel Park:** Especially peaceful areas can be found in the upper part of the hotel park, easily reached via the lift from the spa – ideal for shinrin-yoku and quiet moments of nature meditation.
- **Forest of Mineral Springs & Kneipp Trail:** Healing water, cool air, mossy ground and burbling springs.
- **Glaswaldsee Lake:** A pristine natural lake not far from the Dollenberg – a magical place where the elements come together.

Forest Bathing Tips

- **Duration:** Positive effects can be felt after just 20–30 minutes
- **What to bring:** Sturdy footwear, a raincoat and something to sit on
- **Digital detox:** Switch off your phone – or better yet, leave it at the hotel
- **Mindset:** It's not about achieving – it's about experiencing

Forest bathing here is far more than a simple walk – it's an invitation to slow down, reconnect, and regain strength on every level.

A wildlife conservation project of the

Experience Wild Animals

Native! Wild! Real! – a phrase that captures the spirit of the Alternative Wolf and Bear Park Black Forest. More than just a slogan, it reflects the lives of the park’s residents: amid fir trees and flowing streams, wild animals once kept in captivity, trained for entertainment, or neglected now find refuge in a near-natural environment spanning ten hectares of forest and meadow. Not a zoo, not a traditional animal park – but a conservation project with genuine heart and purpose, located in the Wolf Valley near Bad Rippoldsau–Schapbach.

WILDLIFE, NOT ENTERTAINMENT

Species-appropriate freedom: Spacious open-air enclosures replace a life behind bars. The animals enjoy conditions that prioritise welfare, in a setting designed for protection and rehabilitation.

Rehabilitation instead of Performance:

The animals rediscover their natural instincts and behaviours, appropriate to their species.

Respect Over Sentimentality:

Visitors observe the wildlife from a respectful, mindful distance. The animals are not displayed for entertainment but gently reintroduced to a more natural way of life within a protected environment.

RESIDENTS OF THE PARK

In the park’s spacious enclosures, **bears, wolves and lynx** roam through the Black Forest. Many of these animals were rescued from circuses, private ownership, or inadequate conditions. They now live in species-appropriate groups – or alone, depending on their nature.

TIPS FOR YOUR VISIT

- **Sturdy footwear and warm clothing:** The forest can be cool and occasionally slippery.
- **Arrive early:** Animals tend to be most active in the morning and late afternoon.
- **Photography tip:** A telephoto lens (200 mm or more) allows you to capture great shots without disturbing the animals.



Visitor Experiences

A JOURNEY OF DISCOVERY

- **Scenic woodland paths** through forest and meadow with viewing platforms offering opportunities to observe and photograph the animals in their spacious enclosures. A balanced experience of tranquillity, anticipation and close encounter – not just for the animals, but for visitors as well.
- **Themed play areas and interactive learning**, thoughtfully designed for both children and adults, allow visitors to learn through play about how wild animals truly live.

- **Educational trails** offer insights into behaviour, diet and habitat: Accessible paths suitable for prams and wheelchairs are dotted with learning stations and themed stops. The park is not just a quiet sanctuary – it’s a space for discovery, reflection and education.
- **Special events and behind-the-scenes experiences:** Themed days, guided tours, and educational panels offer rare insights into species conservation and wildlife care. For visitors with limited mobility, the park also offers the Bär-Mobil – a guided vehicle service for up to five guests, enabling easy access to the grounds.

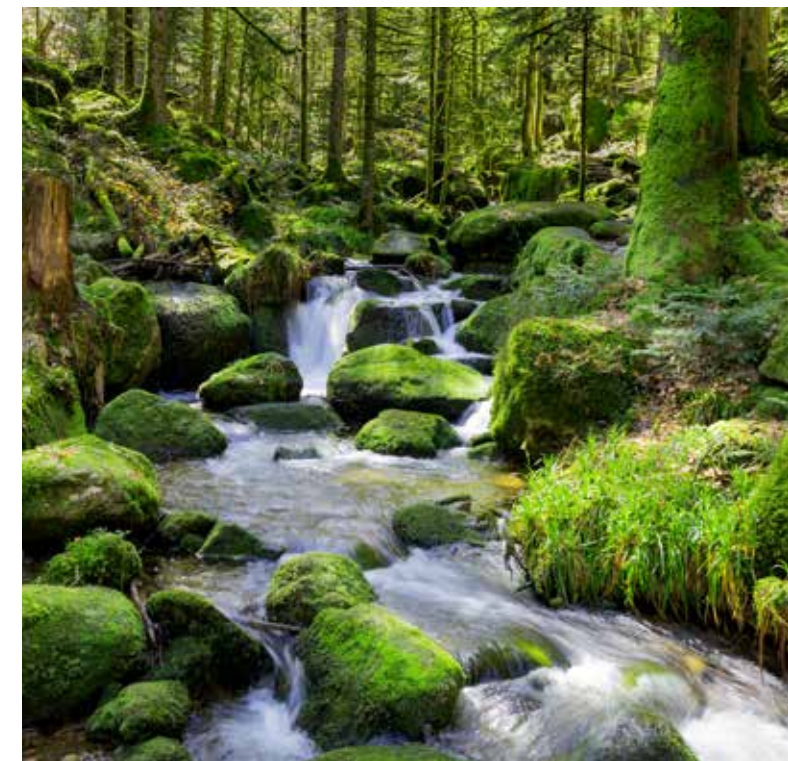

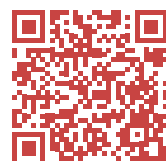

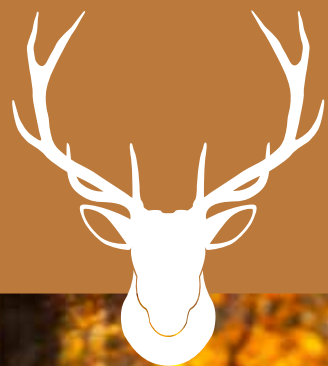
