Our Sweetest Secret

Black Forest

Cake

White as snow, red as blood, black as ebony wood ... this poetic description is as applicable to the Black Forest's traditional costume and its culinary counterpart, the Black Forest cake, as it is to the Brothers Grimm's Snow White. Here, the Dollenberg's chef de cuisine Martin Herrmann reveals the secrets to making the best Black Forest cake.

et whisking! One of the secrets to an excellent Black Forest cake is the lightness of its chocolate sponge base. Gateau after meticulously crafted gateau leaves the Dollenberg's kitchen every day. Together with his pastry chefs, Ivana Juric and Carlotta Rota, Michelin-starred chef de cuisine Martin Herrmann delights in preserving this important slice of Black Forest culture alongside his daily gourmet delights. Our guests get to enjoy the resulting gateaux the cherries on our culinary cake - in the restaurant, on the terraces, or up at the Renchtalhütte. In addition to passion and craftsmanship, the real secret behind 'one of the best cherry cakes in the Black Forest' (Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung) lies in its spirit. Martin Herrmann grins as he explains: 'Authentic Black Forest kirsch, which our boss Meinrad Schmiederer distils himself, gives our cake its very special flavour!' Meinrad Schmiederer tells us more about this very fine tipple on page 22.

The record for the world's largest
Black Forest cake to date was set in
2006: 113 pastry chefs created a
gateau that weighed in at three tons,
measured 80sqm and was divided
into 16,000 slices.

Did you know?

The confectioner Josef Keller, originally from the Swabian Alps, created the forerunner of the Black Forest gateau in 1927 at a coffee house in Bad Godesberg near Bonn. Its basic ingredients were cream, cherries, kirsch, shortcrust pastry and chocolate shavings. His inspiration came from a Black Forest pastry that he remembered from childhood. Over time, Keller refined his recipe and then passed it on to his apprentice, August Schäfer, who opened a café in the 'cake town' of Triberg, thereby bringing the Black Forest cake back to its roots. ### Bake Your Own



#### **OUR SECRET BLACK FOREST CAKE RECIPE**

Serves 16

#### Ingredients

8 eggs

185g sugar

175g plain flour

50g cornflour

35q sugar-free cocoa

600g tin or jar of cherries

400ml cherry juice

300g sugar

50g cornflour, mixed with 10 tbsp cold water and

20ml kirsch

1 cinnamon stick

1 litre cream

9 sheets of gelatine

125q suqar

190ml kirsch

16 candied cherries

Dark chocolate for grating


#### Preparation

Combine eggs and sugar in a mixer, beat for approx. 10 minutes. Sift the flour and cornflour, mix in cocoa and fold into the egg and sugar mixture. Pour the mixture into a 28cm cake tin and bake at 180°C for approx. 30-35 minutes. Allow to cool at room temperature - ideally overnight. Slice the cold sponge cake into three round layers. Use half the kirsch to brush each layer.

Whip the cream. Heat the soaked gelatine with the remaining kirsch and the sugar until the gelatine melts. Add 5 tablespoons of the whipped cream to the gelatine, whisk, and guickly fold into the remaining whipped cream. Set aside.

Bring the cherry juice, sugar and cinnamon to the boil, thicken with the cornflour mixture, and boil for approx. 3 minutes. Stir in the cherries, then allow to cool before chilling in the refrigerator. This is preferably done a day ahead.

Place the bottom layer in a cake ring and spread with whipped cream. Add half the cherries and place another layer of sponge cake over the top. Repeat with cream and the remaining cherries, and place the third sponge cake layer on the top, pressing it down firmly. Spread the cake with cream, and fill a piping bag with the remaining cream. Scatter the dark chocolate shavings over the cake. Mark the cake into 16 equal pieces, and pipe a whipped cream rosette onto each portion. Pop a cherry on each rosette, chill the cake for 1 hour. Slice, serve and enjoy.



### Double Distillation

'Authentic kirsch has to be made exclusively with Black Forest black cherries, anything else and it's not the real thing,' says Meinrad Schmiederer as he sniffs a glass of freshly distilled kirsch. 'The fruity flavour and delicate bitter almond note in Black Forest cherries are critical. They give the fine fruit brandy its classic character,' says the passionate distiller. Meinrad Schmiederer inherited his recipe for the 'best Black Forest kirsch' from his father and grandfather. 'Our kirsch is also what gives our Black Forest cake its unsurpassed flavour.'

Dollenberg Hiking Map



# From the Depths of the Black Forest

Do you drink at least 1.5 litres of water per day? Do you ensure your body gets an adequate supply of minerals? Not sure? In Bad Peterstal-Griesbach, we can confidently say that our natural mineral springs give us everything we need – as well as making the Renchtal and Rottal valleys famous far and wide.

ineral water derives from deep water that slowly but surely makes its way through various layers of rock and earth that filter and purify it while enriching it with minerals and trace elements. Sometimes, the water may also be carbonated. The layers of rock through which the water passes affect its taste, mineral composition and carbonation.

#### **Naturally Healthy**

The most important minerals in natural mineral water are magnesium, calcium and sodium. We need magnesium to build bone and muscle and for energy, productivity and our metabolism. It also helps to combat inflammation. Calcium strengthens bones and teeth and is important for muscle stimulation, nerve conduction and blood clotting. Sodium plays a part in regulating our water balance, acid-base balance and blood pressure.

We have been extracting natural mineral water for drinking and bathing in Bad Peterstal-Griesbach for centuries.

The nature trail offers information about our water, from its origins to its healing powers.

#### **Bad Peterstal Spring**

Famous names such as Emperor Wilhelm I, Johannes Brahms, Victor Hugo and Rainer Maria Rilke were very taken with the effects of the Peterstal's water. In 1980, it won the taste and quality test performed by the American *Consumer Report* publication.

#### Powerful Healing

Discovered in 1214, the Griesbach spring rises in the Renchtal Valley from a depth of 400m where it is protected from environmental pollutants. This mineral water is rich in hydrogen carbonate and has an exceptionally fresh and natural taste thanks to its long journey through the northern Black Forest's limestone layers.

#### The Dollenberg's Pools & Baths

At the DOLLINA Spa & Health, mineral water works its natural magic in the 32°C mineral water bath as well as providing a healthful drink for our guests. The saltwater bath is slightly warmer at 33°C. Guests can cool off in the 15°C mountain lake, and relax in the 34°C whirlpool. The outdoor pool provides breathtaking views as well as all the health benefits of our fresh air.

Griesbacher Recommended by Chef Martin Herrmann

To qualify as natural mineral water, it must originate in subterranean water reserves protected from contamination, be bottled at the source, and contain a specific amount of minerals and trace elements.

#### **SOPHIENQUELLE**

The Sophienquelle spring was discovered by Franz Xaver Kimmig in 1835. He had a pavilion built over it where even today you can enjoy water fresh from the spring. Two years later it was named for Grand Duchess Sophie, patroness of the Bad Peterstal and Bad Griesbach baths. The pavilion over the spring, known as the *Brunnentempel*, or well temple, is Bad Peterstal-Griesbach's landmark.

WATER TRAIL

The Wasserlehrpfad educational trail is almost 6km long and includes Bad Peterstal-Griesbach. 17 boards along the way give you all kinds of interesting information about our water and its healing effects.

Route length: 5.7km | Altitude difference: around 160m

#### <u>Tip 1:</u>

Choose wisely

The Finnish sauna's temperatures of 90°C, or more, are not for everyone. You should therefore choose the sauna that is best for your wellbeing. At 90-95°C, our reclaimed wood sauna is our hottest. A little cooler, the Swiss pine sauna reaches temperatures of 80-85°C and calms the heartbeat thanks to the wood's proven beneficial properties. Head for the bio sauna for moderate heat of 50-60° - nice and gentle on your circulation. The 50°C dry salt sauna, the herbal steam bath (50°C) and saline steam bath (60°C) do wonders for the respiratory system.

#### <u>Tip 2:</u>

Cool down

A key part of taking a sauna is the cooling down process. The contrast between hot and cold can intensify health benefits, ensuring a lasting effect on circulation and immune system. Depending on how robust your circulation is, you can either choose to cool down gently by slowly rubbing your body down at the ice fountain, or rapidly with a quick dip in our mountain lake.





#### <u>Tip 3:</u>

Rest

After the sauna, treat yourself to some fresh air and at least half an hour of rest. Let your thoughts go. Enjoy the warm and pleasant feeling on your skin and restore fluid levels by sipping our mineral water.





## Dollenberg



Meinrad Schmiederer takes us on a wine tour for mind and palate. Today, he visits Oberkircher Winzer in search of the Dollenberg cuvées.



#### Mr Bäuerle, why don't you start by introducing Oberkircher Winzer.

The Oberkircher Winzer vinery in Baden is in the Renchtal Valley in beautiful Oberkirch. We are a cooperative of regional winemakers who cultivate wines together, so to speak. With a total of 670 hectares, Oberkircher Winzer – plus the Hex winegrower's cellar in Dasenstein, also part of the group – is one of the most important winemakers' cooperatives in Baden. The wine-growing area between the peaks of the Black Forest and the Rhine valley is cultivated by around 400 member families.

#### What makes Oberkircher Winzer so special?

Every day we strive to achieve the



highest possible quality, from the vineyard to the wine cellar. This has earned us many accolades; in 2023 we were named the best winemakers' cooperative in Baden, and in 2022 the best winemakers' cooperative in Germany. At the Dollenberg Burgundy and Riesling Gala, which each year selects the TOP TEN wines in the Ortenau region, Oberkircher Winzer has often won the Dollenberg Trophy.

#### What makes Oberkirch such a special location?

Oberkirch is located at the heart of Baden in the wine-growing region of Ortenau. Our vineyard sites have residual granite soil, which stores




warmth during the day and cools quickly at night. Combined with the night-time down draughts of the Black Forest and the significant differences in temperature, this lends an outstanding fruitiness to the wines that grow here.

#### What grape varieties do you cultivate?

The Acher and Renchtal Valleys, where our vines grow, have many vineyards growing on steep ground and on terraces, and each site has its own characteristics. The cultivation area ranges from 200m to 430m above sea level with great differences in vegetation, meaning that the grape varieties can grow in the conditions that suit them best. As a result, I can blend unique wines by selecting from a wide range of aromas. The main grape variety is the Pinot Noir and, for white wine, the world-famous Riesling. Pinot Gris and Pinot Blanc are constantly increasing, as are Chardonnay and Lagrein.

#### How do you manage to produce these premium wines every year?

Since 2002 we have had a quality manager who supports the winemakers all year round as they



work in the vineyards. He is highly knowledgeable and undertakes quality testing on site. In the cellar, I can utilise a range of innovative maturing techniques to produce excellent work and tailor my efforts in the speciality field. My signature is round wines that caress the mouth, perfectly combining diversity and complexity.

#### How did you come to work with the Hotel Dollenberg and what makes the Dollenberg cuvée stand out?

The 5-star hotel came to us looking for a special, region-specific wine. We guickly opted for a Pinot Gris and a Pinot Noir, both matured largely in barrique barrels. Meinrad Schmiederer and

Christophe Meyer took me to the cellar where we tasted numerous wines stored in barrique barrels. Our close and trusting collaboration with the hotel has produced a monovarietal cuvée loved by guests and praised at prestigious tasting competitions.

#### The Dollenberg cuvée has also won awards. Can you tell us more about this?

We submit our wines to various competitions, pitting ourselves against other winemakers. The Dollenberg cuvée has won many GOLD medals at AWC Vienna, Vinum, TopTen-Baden and the DLG. Most recently, the 2021 Dollenberg Pinot Gris was named the best premium wine at the Meininger Pinot tasting.

## The Capercaillie


Pascal Herrmann, a hunter and gamekeeper with a deep passion for the natural world, believes that hunting and nature conservation are two sides of the same coin. Here he tells us about saving the Black Forest National Park's capercaillies from extinction.

hy and retiring, this member of the grouse family is a popular artist's motif. It is also loved by hunters, although nowadays they're not interested in the kill; only on protecting the bird from extinction. The capercaillie is on Germany's red list of threatened species and therefore subject to a hunting ban. The non-migratory bird is found in only a few areas of Germany: the Black

The capercaillie is a shy creature that loves peace and quiet, especially during the mating and breeding seasons.

Forest, Berchtesgadener Land, the Bavarian Forest and the Fichtel Mountains.

The capercaillie is very timid and requires a very specific habitat with plenty of peace and quiet. During the breeding season, *Tetrao urogallus* (Latin for capercaillie) is particularly sensitive to disturbance. As it has few options for expanding its spatial distribution, small populations are easily isolated and die out.

#### Capercaillie Emergency Plan

'To maintain a stable capercaillie population, you need a few thousand hectares of land in its pristine, natural state. The Black Forest National Park is perfect for this,' explains Herrmann. 'But even here, we've had to control and expand existing protective measures because the human impact is too great,' he says. The Black Forest National Park's

2022 and is currently set to continue for five years. A major step is protecting the forest's traditional mating and chick rearing locations. Hence, paths in the park are closed during periods of increased breeding activity. At least 100 hectares around the mapped breeding locations are subject to additional measures to allow an increase in the number of red deer. Deer make a significant contribution to the creation of suitable habitats by keeping shrubs short and creating open spaces. 'One year on, things are looking good; the capercaillie population hasn't reduced any further,' says Herrmann happily. However, nobody's about to rest on their laurels. 'It'll take a few years before all the measures take effect. We'll also need to implement them across the whole Black Forest to ensure genetic exchange and thus long-term reproduction.'
