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


# The Cuckoo's Call

Much more than just a timekeeping instrument, the cuckoo clock symbolises the craftsmanship and heritage of the Black Forest. Here's the fascinating story behind this world-renowned souvenir.

All eyes are fixed on the tiny door as the minute hand strikes twelve. The door swings open, and a small bird pops out, calling 'cuckoo, cuckoo ...' Sometimes, viewers are so captivated they forget to count the hour the clock is marking! After its performance, the cuckoo retreats into its little house, awaiting the next full hour.

## French Inspiration

Where did this idea originate? The inspiration likely travelled to the Black Forest through trade routes from Strasbourg Cathedral, where a crowing rooster marked the hours. Resourceful craftsmen, eager to match the fine clocks made in France, sought to learn from French clockmakers. By the mid-18th century, they had brought this



expertise back to their homeland, laying the groundwork for the Black Forest's clockmaking boom. By 1808, clockmaking was a well-established craft in the town of Schönau, and in 1850, the Duke of Baden founded a clockmaking school in Furtwangen, which remains a prestigious technical college to this day.

## More Than Just a Souvenir

The Black Forest cuckoo clock has remained largely unchanged over the years. It stands as one of the most iconic symbols of German craftsmanship worldwide. People from all corners of the globe are enchanted by the blend of technology, precision, and artistry. The cuckoo's iconic call and the intricate designs of these clocks captivate both casual viewers and dedicated collectors. For the people of the Black Forest, the cuckoo clock represents a treasured part of their history, one that played a significant role in shaping the region's development.



### Engineering Prowess

**Craftsmanship:** Every cuckoo clock is handcrafted with intricate wood carvings. The most iconic clock cases are shaped like traditional Black Forest houses.

**Mechanical Wall Clock & Chronometer:** The classic cuckoo wall clock features a mechanical pendulum movement with a chain drive and a striking mechanism that mimics the call of a cuckoo. A mechanical cuckoo emerges from a small door every hour, calling out with its characteristic cuckoo call. When regularly wound, the clocks are precise timekeepers.



# Sustainable *Habitat*

The iconic Black Forest house is much more than a functional structure; it is a symbol of the region's identity and culture, embodying the deep bond between people and nature.

**F**or centuries, both people and livestock have lived harmoniously under the imposing, deeply overhanging hipped roof of the traditional Black Forest house. The living areas face the hillside, with the bedrooms situated above. This arrangement allows hay to be transported directly from the mountainside into the hayloft. The kitchen is positioned at the rear. The expansive wooden shingle roof protects the hay, which serves as winter fodder for the cattle housed directly below. This clever design is perfectly suited to the Black Forest's unique climate.

### A Legacy of Sustainability

Long before sustainability became a trend, the Black Forest house stood as an outstanding example of eco-friendly construction. Built almost entirely from local materials such as wood and stone, these homes were designed to be self-sufficient and environmentally conscious. The large roofs collected rainwater, and the timber used for construction often came from the surrounding forests, ensuring minimal transport distances. The Black Forest house was designed to bring together the family, livestock and harvest under one roof for generations, creating self-sustaining communities with a high degree of autonomy and stability.



At its heart was the open parlour, centred around a traditional tiled stove. This welcoming space served as the hub of daily life – a place for work, family and shared moments of comfort.


### Space for Living & Storytelling

The interiors of the Black Forest house were designed with flexibility in mind, adapting to seasonal needs. During the summer, the hayloft was filled to capacity, while in winter, the space above the stable was used for storage or as a workroom, warmed by the heat from the animals below. The threshing room, typically located just after the entrance, was a multifunctional area where grain was threshed, tools were stored, and various tasks requiring ample space were carried out. It was also where guests were received. Large masonry stoves, adorned with green tiles and heated benches, provided the cosiest spot in a Black Forest house. Known as Kunscht, these stoves became the hub of activity where people gathered, worked or slept, and where stories were shared during long, dark winter evenings.

# Did you know?

The sight of a typical Black Forest house instantly evokes a sense of arrival at your holiday destination. It is a favourite subject for photographers, both visitors and local wedding couples alike. But what makes these buildings so special?

- » ♦ The various types of Black Forest houses were perfectly adapted to their location on a slope or in a valley.
- » ♦ Thanks to their unique construction, these houses are incredibly robust, capable of withstanding heavy snowfalls and strong winds.
- » ♦ Each floor served a specific purpose: the cellar at the bottom was used for storing food; the next floor up was for living, cooking, and housing cattle; above that were the sleeping quarters, workshop, and wood store; and at the top, hay and vehicles were kept. The hipped roofs extended nearly to the ground, providing shade in summer and keeping snow off the outer paths in winter, allowing easy movement around the house.
- » ♦ Some Black Forest houses are over 400 years old, a testament to the durability of this architectural style.
- » ♦ The gable of a Black Forest house was often intricately decorated, sometimes reflecting the social status or craftsmanship of the owners. Wealthy farmers and artisans showcased their affluence through particularly elaborate designs. The cosy parlours were the heart of farm life, where typically at least three generations lived together.


## Excursion Tip

### Black Forest Vogtsbauernhof Open Air Museum

At the heart of this museum is the Vogtsbauernhof farmhouse, which stands on its original site. With around 220,000 visitors per season (March to November), it is one of the most popular day-trip destinations in the Black Forest, offering fascinating insights into the region's rural cultural heritage.





# Wellspring of *Identity*

Bad Peterstal-Griesbach's Sparkling History. Travel with us through time: from the discovery of the mineral water springs to the Dollenberg's mineral water spa.

**A**long the banks of the River Rench in the northern Black Forest, you'll find the spa town of Bad Peterstal-Griesbach.

Originally two separate municipalities – Bad Peterstal and Bad Griesbach – the town has been known for over 400 years for its healing mineral springs and mild, sub-alpine climate. It's the perfect destination to revitalise your mind and body, with a captivating history to match.

## **An Eventful History**

The history of Bad Peterstal-Griesbach is deeply intertwined with its mineral springs. The earliest indications of the springs' benefits date back to the 16th century when they were primarily used by the rural population.

In 1763, Baron von Bock took the first steps towards establishing the area as a spa town by commissioning a systematic analysis of the springs. Under his guidance, the foundation for Griesbach's development as a health destination was laid. A few years later, administrator Anton Monsch built the first drinking hall, where the spring water was served. Even in the 18th century, spa guests were drawn to the area, valuing the curative effects of the mineral water.

Bad Peterstal dates back to 1293 when a chapel, which eventually grew into a parish church dedicated to the Apostle Peter, was built. The settlement was initially called *Zuo Sant Peter in Noppenowertal*.

Bad Griesbach was first mentioned as *Grußenbach* in 1330. Located at the end of the Rench Valley at the foot of the Kniebis – one of the area's highest peaks – this location offers a truly idyllic setting.

Dr Böckmann, a prominent supporter, further promoted the springs by publishing medical writings on their health benefits. By the late 19th century, Bad Griesbach had become a celebrated spa town, offering not only drinking cures but also therapeutic treatments using the mineral water.

Over time, the spa expanded, introducing modern facilities and innovative therapy concepts. In 1968, the recognition of Griesbach mineral water as certified healing water reinforced its status as a destination for health and regeneration, renowned far beyond the region.

### Mineral Water as a Wellspring of Identity

The history and development of Bad Peterstal-Griesbach are inseparably tied to the discovery and evolution of its mineral water springs.

In 1835, Franz Xaver Kimmig uncovered the first captured spring in Bad Peterstal, later named the Sophienquelle. He enclosed the spring and built a pavilion over it, sparking interest among doctors and spa visitors. Just three years later, in 1838, Andreas Kessler discovered two additional springs near his farm, converting one into a mineral spring. Despite its popularity among locals and spa guests, official approval for spa or hospitality operations was not granted for some time. At the turn of the century, Emil Huber began professionally bottling the mineral water. He established Peterstaler Mineralquellen GmbH in 1926 and expanded operations by acquiring the Bald Rippoldsau mineral spring in 1941.

The beginnings of Griesbach's mineral springs can be traced back to 1935, when Erwin Winkels leased land in the Wilde Rench area.

Through excavation, he uncovered a spring and built a wooden structure where he began bottling mineral water. After World War II, Winkels opened his first factory building. Following his passing, the Griesbach

mineral water company merged with the Karlsruhe Durlach operation and continued as a family business under the management of his son-in-law, Gerhard Rummler. In 1968, after significant growth and development, Bad Griesbach mineral water was officially recognised as a curative water.

### The Modern Period

The last Griesbach mineral water spring was tapped in 1996, ensuring an abundant supply of high-quality natural mineral water. This precious resource feeds the mineral water spa at the Dollenberg, which guests value for its soothing and healing properties.

Griesbach mineral water is proudly championed by our Chef de Cuisine, Martin Herrmann. He not only recommends this healthy, sparkling refreshment in his Michelin-starred restaurant, but also uses it himself. For him, water is the perfect companion to his exquisite dishes and a symbol of the harmony between tradition and enjoyment.



In the mid-1990s, the Dollenberg spa facilities were connected to the mineral water spring.

### History at a Glance

- 1578:** The mineral springs of Bad Griesbach are first used for their curative properties.
- 1677:** A major fire devastates Bad Griesbach, leading to a decline in visitors.
- 1679:** Schuttern Abbey takes over and rebuilds Bad Griesbach.
- 1763:** Bad Griesbach is sold into private ownership.
- 1809:** The municipality of Griesbach is founded under the name Döttelbach.
- 1863:** The municipality is renamed Griesbach.
- 1932:** Griesbach gains spa town status and is renamed Bad Griesbach.
- 1970s:** Bad Peterstal and Bad Griesbach merge to form Bad Peterstal-Griesbach.





# Where Nature Breathes

Where nature is allowed to develop undisturbed, it constantly reinvents itself. In the Black Forest National Park, it tells its own story.

**W**hen left undisturbed, the wilderness thrives and continuously reinvents itself, offering a captivating, ever-changing landscape. At the National Park Centre in Ruhestein, a permanent multimedia exhibition reveals what happens when humanity steps back and lets nature take the lead. The centre's architecture, inspired by stacked deadwood, mirrors the untamed forest surroundings. Visitors can



On their hikes, visitors discover artistic interventions such as hidden sculptures and installations made from moss and wood, connecting visitors even more strongly with the landscape.

explore interactive exhibits showcasing the park's diverse habitats, including forests, moorlands, and wildlife. A small cinema features stunning films about the park, and rangers are available to answer any questions. Outside, installations provide hands-on opportunities to engage with and learn about the natural world.

### Good to Know

The Black Forest National Park, now over 10 years old, encompasses a diverse range of landscapes – forests, moors, highland pastures, and lakes. Idyllic, serene areas stand in contrast to the park's wilder, more untamed regions, each offering its own unique charm. As part of the Natura 2000 network, the park plays a vital role in preserving and developing rich biological diversity.

### Adventure Trails in the National Park

For those eager to explore beyond the exhibition,

the park offers hiking, cycling, and guided tours with park rangers. These experiences allow visitors to fully immerse themselves in the magic of the forest, engaging all their senses.


### Recommendations

**Lothar Trail (30 min):** A walk over boardwalks, steps, and ladders, ending at an observation platform with panoramic views of the northern Black Forest's high ridges and valleys.

**Lynx Trail (approx. 3 hrs):** Starting at the Luchshütte lodge, this trail explores the woodlands where lynx are thoroughly at home.

**Wilderness Trail (approx. 3 hrs):** Wander through a forest that has been left to regenerate naturally since 1999's Storm 'Lothar'.

**Woodpecker Trail (45 min):** Accessible and step-free, this trail with gentle inclines introduces all five woodpecker species found in the park.


# A Story of Forest and Wood

The Black Forest has a rich and eventful history, deeply intertwined with its woodlands and natural resources. For millennia, this dense and mysterious forest has been both a place of refuge and a valuable source of raw materials.

**I**n the past, every farm in the Black Forest owned a plot of woodland. These areas were once difficult to access, as forest paths were few and far between. Farmers and labourers often began their day with a long trek into the rugged terrain. In those days, woodsmen relied solely on axes. Before a felled tree could be transported, they had to remove its branches and bark. To transport as many of the massive trunks as possible from the remote forest, the inhabitants of the Black Forest constructed reinforced timber slides, known as *Riesen*.

**Timber Rafting**

Log driving was the primary method of transporting timber until the 19th century. Raftsmen would bind logs together and navigate them from the Black Forest down the Rhine to Amsterdam, where the timber was in high demand for building houses and ships.



**Wood for Glass Blowing**

Beyond everyday items, entire industries depended on wood. The Black Forest, now celebrated for its dense woodlands and breathtaking landscapes, was once renowned for its glass-blowing industry. However, there would have been no sparkling glass without the forests' seemingly abundant energy resources. Wood, or rather charcoal, fuelled the glassworks' fiery furnaces. Charcoal burners worked deep in the forest, converting wood into charcoal. This charcoal supplied the glassworks with the immense energy needed to manufacture the precious commodities of everyday life.

**'A woodsman's work was dangerous. There were many accidents. Even now, accidents happen. I know that there have even been fatalities in the forest – not just during felling, but also on the timber slides. Bringing down firewood on the timber slides was extremely hazardous, and many people lost their lives doing it.'**







### Dollenberg indulgence half board

Lavish breakfast buffet. Room rates include breakfast. Guests who stay for 3 nights or more with half board can also enjoy a 6-course dinner for €39 per person/night.
